## **English**

#### This term our key texts will be:

- The Great Explorer

Early on, we will be looking at the structure of a sentence. Highlighting the subject, verb and object. We will be learning to write in past tense in preparation for the children to write their own diary. Finally, we will be learning to write a powerful description piece. We will also have weekly phonics and handwriting lessons.

## **Computing**

#### This term we will be focusing on:

- Learning how to stay safe online.


# **PSHE - Jigsaw**

Concrete - using objects and equipment

Pictorial - represent their thinking using pictures

Abstract - using numbers and symbols to solve calculations

**Geography:** This term we will be leaning about the weather and the difference in climate in hot countries to the South poles.

**RE:** This term, we will be learning about what prayer is and the Easter celebration.
